**WRITING**

Over the next few weeks we will be using the Talk for Writing Booklet 'The King of the Fishes' as a basis for Miss Scott's English lessons. Towards the end of this half term we will be writing a Non-chronological report based on the Anglo Saxons.

Mrs Kelly's lessons will begin by looking at a David Attenborough wildlife video. The learning intentions include:

- Listening, sequencing events, and using a storyboard to write an account.
- Revise and practise adverbials. Write sentences with adverbials for the story.
- Write stories, including adverbials.
- Identify noun phrases in sentences. Read a poem, write own version.
- Understand that prepositions can add information to a noun phrase.

Activities will also include writing tasks from Pobble 365.
