Counting aloud in 2's, 5's and 10's – They could use objects around the house to help them. Use a ruler or measuring tape to measure objects or people. <p><b>DAILY READING</b> This is a great opportunity to read some good books together at home. Your child could write some book reviews or may be inspired to make up their own ending to the story, they could draw pictures and talk about their favourite part of the story. Can you be caught reading? Send me a photo of yourself through Class Dojo reading.  Read the High Frequency word sheet provided as often as possible – Make it fun by timing them to see how many words they can read in 30 seconds!</p>			
<p><b>PHONICS</b> Use the sheets in the pack provided: Add sound buttons (sausages and beans as we call them in class) to each word before sounding and blending the word aloud. Practise using the Phonics past papers provided. Continue to use the posters provided at the Phonics Screening Check meeting.
