<p><b>Nursery</b></p>	<p>Through both continuous provision and adult-led activities, children will learn -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To understand that they can use lines to enclose a space, and then begin to use these shapes to represent objects</li> <li>To begin to explore a variety of drawing tools</li> <li>To explore colour and how colours can be changed</li> <li>To begin to be interested in and describe the texture of things</li> <li>To begin to construct/stack blocks vertically and horizontally, make enclosures and create spaces</li> <li>To print with variety of objects</li> <li>To realise tools can be used for a purpose</li> <li>To use physical objects to create patterns</li> </ul>		
<p><b>Reception</b></p>	<p>Through both continuous provision and adult-led activities, children will learn -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To create simple representations of events, people and objects</li> <li>To explore what happens when they mix colours</li> <li>To use words to describe how things feel in their hands</li> <li>To create collage with varying textures and discuss the differences</li> <li>To manipulate materials to achieve a planned effect</li> <li>To construct with a purpose in mind, using a variety of resources</li> <li>To create natural leaf/bark rubbings</li> <li>To print with block colours</li> <li>To select tools and techniques needed to shape, assemble and join materials they are using</li> <li>To independently create repeating patterns</li> <li>To create irregular painting patterns</li> <li>To find symmetry in nature</li> </ul>
