

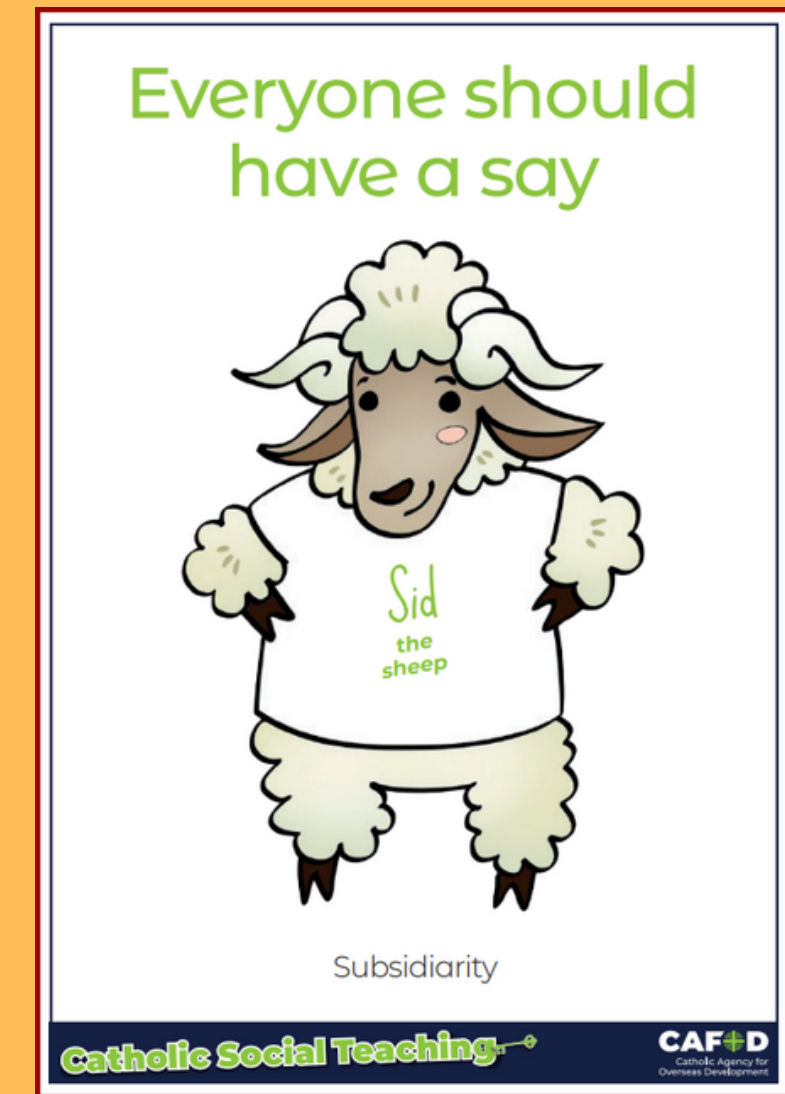
Subsidiarity
